



Mission: The Capitola Wharf Enhancement Project will raise funds to enhance the rebuilt Capitola Wharf.

- \$7.7M: Congress, 2016 Capitola sales tax, & state funds
- Widen the area closest to the shore from 20ft to 36ft
- Double the number of pilings to 120
- Replace the whole deck
- Replace all the railings

# SUMMARY OF THE COMMUNITY'S NEW VISION


- Replace all old lighting standards so they match

- Updated fish cleaning station


